CARROT ROOT FLY  
KILLER NEMATODES

### REQUIRED CONDITIONS:

- Soil temperature must be above 10°C
- Do not apply the nematodes in bright sunshine as nematodes are U.V sensitive
- Ensure soil is moist before applying nematodes

### 10SQM PACK APPLICATION:

- Open sachet and empty entire contents into a bucket of 0.5L of lukewarm water
- Stir thoroughly to break up and dissolve carrier material
- Add 0.5L of the nematode concentrate to a watering can with up to 10L of water
- One pack of 10sqm nematodes will make 1 watering can (including concentrate solution)
- Apply to vegetable plots, raised or open beds using a coarse rose/nozzle
- One watering can treats 10sqm
- Use of all the contents of the pack once opened. Made up solution cannot be stored
- The nematodes can also be applied with some hose end feeder / nematode applicators & sprayers such as our Nema Super Sprayer

### 20SQM PACK APPLICATION:

- Open sachet and empty entire contents into a bucket of 1L of lukewarm water
- Stir thoroughly to break up and dissolve carrier material
- Add 0.5L of the nematode concentrate to a watering can with up to 10L of water
- One pack of 20sqm nematodes makes 2 watering cans (including concentrate solution)
- Apply to vegetable plots, raised or open beds using a coarse rose/nozzle
- Each watering can treats 10sqm
- Use of all the contents of the pack once opened. Made up solution cannot be stored
- The nematodes can also be applied with some hose end feeder / nematode applicators & sprayers such as our Nema Super Sprayer

### STORAGE:

- If you cannot apply immediately, store in the fridge (4°C) and use as soon as possible
- Do not freeze the nematodes

### NEXT STEPS:

- Water area treated after use and keep moist for a week after application
- Repeat application, if required, every four weeks until no Carrot Fly larvae are present
